Sutton Inclusion Centre

Started in February, One Trust now runs a satellite service at the Sutton Inclusion Centre. Currently 8 people using One Trust services now spend every Tuesday at this new resource. This service was started partly to provide additional capacity for our popular and oversubscribed Church Lane resource and also so that we could incorporate regular hydrotherapy into our weekly service offering. Hydrotherapy has been in very short supply over the years, yet for many people with physical disability, this therapy is vital. It alleviates discomfort for those with spasticity and enables those that usually spend much of their lives seated that opportunity to be upright. It also provides a very enjoyable and stimulating environment. Janet Todd has joined our team on Tuesdays bringing her expertise in physic and hydrotherapy. This project is also delivered by a dedicated One Trust team and Luke our art therapist is also in residence at the Inclusion Centre on Tuesdays. In the future we hope that we will be invited to use the Inclusion Centre on other days of the week, so that we can make sure everyone that needs hydrotherapy will be able to have regular access to the much sought after intervention.

Sensory Garden Completed

After a couple of years in the pipeline, the One Trust sensory garden is now complete. GGS the landscape gardening contractor have been fantastic, translating a set of drawn plans into a truly magnificent garden space. One Trust plans to have a grand opening of the garden in the summer, however it will be used extensively prior to the official opening.
